

FIG. 1 - TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC




FIG. 2 - TYPICAL FORWARD 8 CURRENT DERATING CURVE AVERAGE FORWARD CURENT, 5 Single Phase Half Wave 60Hz 4 Resistive or Inductive Load 3 2 25 50 75 100 125 150 175 AMBIENT TEMPERATURE (°C)

FIG. 4 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




FIG. 5 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT




FIG. 6 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
